

Review Game - Get out a bucket and a ball. Designate a starting line. Have your child toss the ball and try to get it into the bucket. When the ball makes it into the bucket ask your child a review question. Continue until all questions are answered. (you could substitute the ball/bucket for a basketball hoop/basketball or a hula hoop and stuffed animal, etc.)

Tic-Tac-Toe Review - Make a tic-tac-toe board on your floor using tape (or on your driveway using chalk) Use bean bags or different colored chalk to represent X and Os. Ask your child a review question, then they ask you a review question. When someone answers a question correctly, they get to throw a bean bag onto the Tic Tac Toe "board". Each team tries to be the first to get a line of three completed.

Four Corners Review - Turn your review questions into multiple choice questions. Name the corners of your room A, B, C, D. Ask the review questions. Students walk, hop, skip, etc. to the corner of the room they think the answer is.

Story Telling - watch the Bible story together. Then start to draw the story and see if your child(ren) can fill in the rest. Switch - let your child draw the story.

Air Plane Review - Make a paper airplane. Hang up poster board so that the airplanes can fly through it. Each hole in the poster board has an assigned point value. Have your child toss the paper airplane at the poster board. If they make it, ask a review question. If they get the question correct, they will receive the number of points that the hole was worth.
