

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## What is Central Sports Volleyball?

Central Sports Volleyball is a Christ-centered volleyball league where we strive for fun, growth, and respect. We want players to have fun while playing, grow as a player throughout the year, and play to win, but not at all costs. #### When and where is Meet the Team?

Thursday, August 25th in the gym 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> Grade division – 6:00-6:20 pm 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade division – 6:30-6:50 pm

## When does practice start?

Week of August 29th

## When are practices?

Practices are only once per week. Your team will practice on the same court, at the same time, on the same night every week. Times are 5:30, 6:30, or 7:30 pm.

## When is the first game and last game?

First Game – September 17 Last Game – November 5 (all games are on Saturdays)

## Can I request a certain coach?

Unfortunately, due to the number of kids playing we cannot honor coach requests.

## When will I know what team, coach, and night of practice my child has?

Our coach trainings are on August 22nd and 23rd. Coaches will receive their roster before or on that night and should contact you before Meet the Team.

## What if I don't hear from my coach before Meet the Team?

You can contact the office and we will let you know, or you can find them at Meet the Team.

## What if I can't make meet the team, a practice, or a game?

It is ok, just let your coach know.

# If I have multiple kids playing, will they be on the same team or on the same night of practice?

If the children are in the same age division, they will be on the same team. We do everything possible to put siblings on the same night for practice.

## Are knee pads required?

## What size ball do they use?

1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> Grade – volley-lite volleyball 4<sup>th</sup>- 6<sup>th</sup> Grade – full-size volleyball

## What do the players receive?

A jersey, shorts, sticker, Bible, volleyball, medal
