## Missions Minister Central Church

## **Position Summary**

The Missions Minister is the key person responsible for directing Central Church's outreach and sending strategy locally, nationally, and internationally. This full-time ministry staff role serves on Central's Next Generation team and reports to the Executive Pastor.

## **Position Responsibilities**

- Ministry Leadership: Recruits, trains, and oversees all aspects of missions ministry, including its staff, operations, and volunteers. Drives a comprehensive ministry strategy to deploy short-term and long-term missionary efforts locally, nationally, and internationally. Preaches, teaches, and counsels regularly as a minister at Central Church.
- **Disciple-Making:** Works to cultivate a sending culture at Central by growing a heart for the nations in our people, training them to live a life on mission. Directs programs and ministry efforts that are theologically faithful and rigorous. Shows himself to be particularly attune to the non-Christians and unchurched and displays an innovative spirit that seeks to engage, evangelize, and equip with excellence and faithfulness.
- **Ministry Development**: Expands international efforts to reach the lost in Bryan-College Station, especially student and international population. Builds comprehensive support plan for missionaries that cares for them spiritually, financially, and relationally. Helps plant & revitalize churches in Texas and around the U.S. through sending of leaders and lay people. Establishes partnerships with like-minded organizations and churches. Impacts community through compassionate opportunities to meet needs.
- **Strategist:** Supports the Executive Pastor, contributing oversight and guidance to special projects and strategic initiatives as needed, especially as related to supporting a training and sending pipeline to raise up and send out the next generation of ministers and missionaries through a residency.
