Vige Voman Highlight: Laura Hammong




The basics:

Laura has been at Central since 1992. She is married with two teenage boys and has been involved in the Central women's ministry since 2016, helping with Bible study, events, and women's mentoring. She also serves as a regional representative for the Southern Baptists of Texas Convention (SBTC) Women's Ministry, which supports women's ministry leaders and hosts the She Stands women's conferences in locations across Texas. She works full-time at Texas A&M University in the College of Veterinary Medicine & Biomedical Sciences as an Instructional Technologist.



From Laura: "I love learning, reading, traveling, going to women's conferences, deep conversation, and Bible study. While I'm definitely an introvert, I've learned the importance of being in community, building friendships, and investing in mentoring relationships, where we point each other to Christ. I've been on both sides of the table, mentoring and being mentored, and I think both are so **important.** The women's mentoring team helps connect women to mentors and encourages and equips women to mentor others. We really just want to support a culture of mentoring at Central, one where women are intentional in their relationships with each other. I want to encourage women to be involved in women's ministry and find ways to deeply connect with other women. Walking alongside other believers has been so important to my own walk with the Lord. I also want women to know you don't have to be an expert to be a mentor, and you don't have to be a certain age. You just need to be growing in your walk with God. I really do believe we all need someone a bit ahead of us and someone behind us to walk with."
