Who the king is (6:1), what he has done (8:2-4), what He will do (8:7-10), and how Israel is to respond (8:11-14,18-19)

(6:7 – home) (9:4-8 – holiness, Luke 18:9-14)

III. (C) 12:1-26:15 Specific stipulations and forward  
look

(debt 15:1) (slave 15:12)

III. (D) 27:1-34 Curses and blessings  
Ebal and Gerizim (altar on Ebal)

    curses on blessings only
